- Rewarded academic and social success through recognition awards

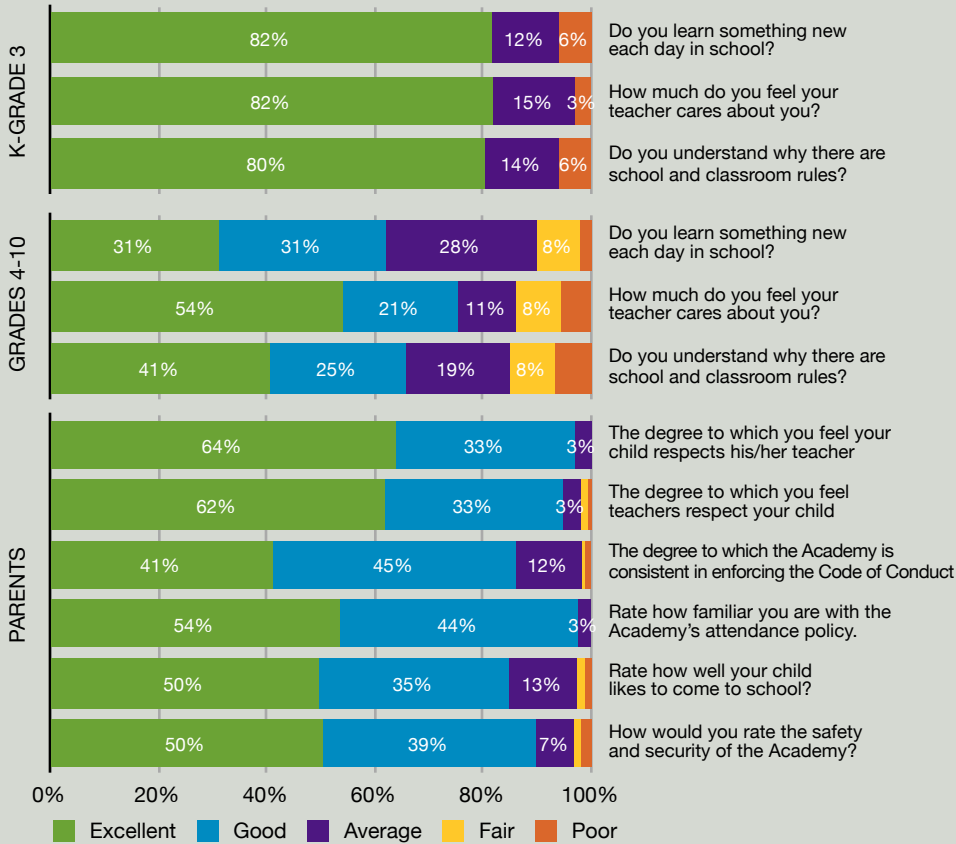

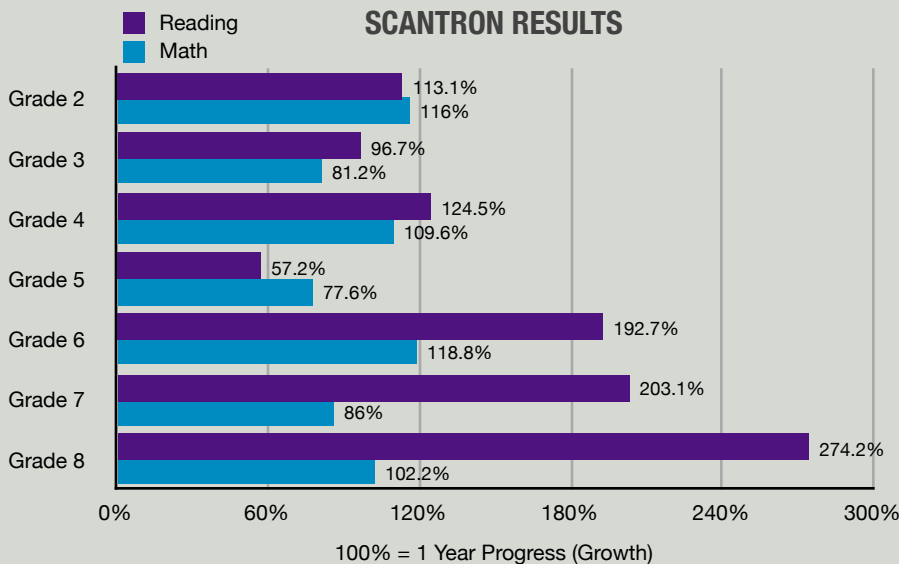
## STUDENT AND PARENT SURVEY RESULTS

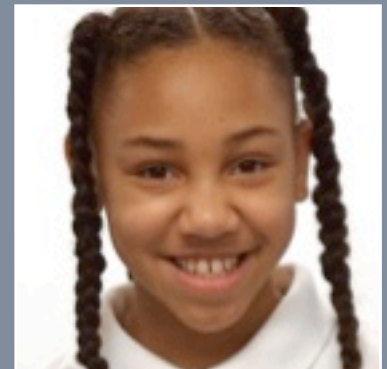

## HOURS OF INSTRUCTION

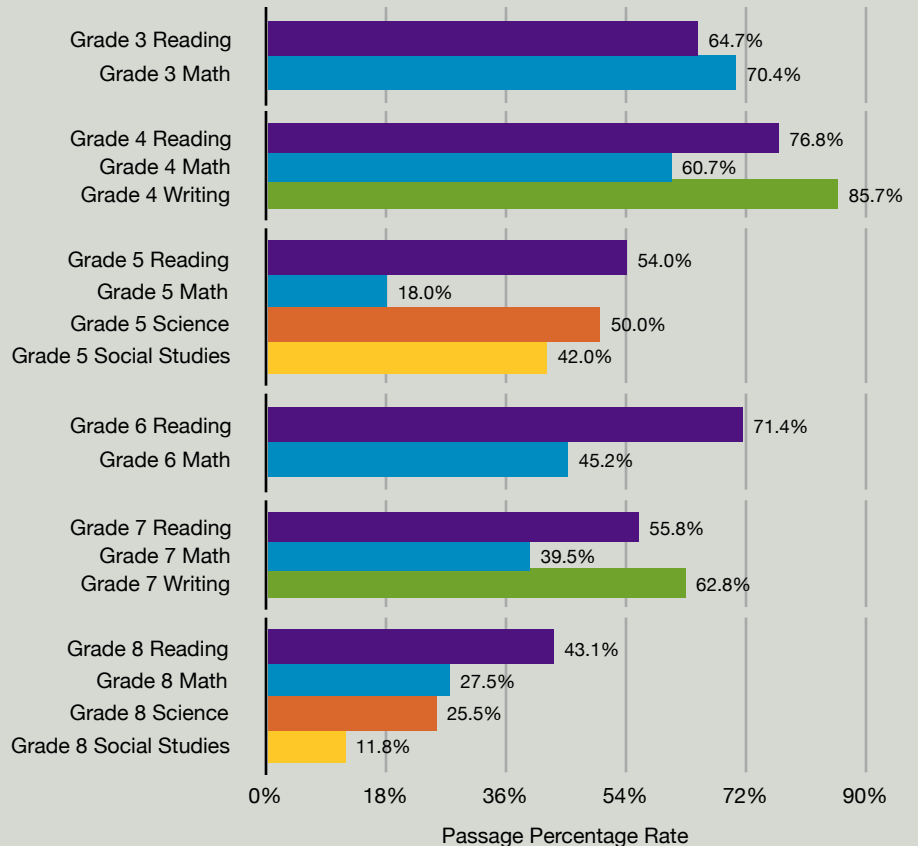
Our school provided 1,002 hours of instruction, which exceeds the 920 hours required by Ohio law. This time excludes non-academic activities.
